- **MONDAY 13 NOVEMBER**

- Extraordinary University Senate Meeting, with the University Restructure being the one and only topic of conversation

- **WEDNESDAY 22 NOVEMBER**

- Scheduled University Senate Meeting where number of Faculties, Faculty titles and the discipline breakdown was agreed

- **JANUARY 2018**

- Presumed meeting of University Council to confirm what University Senate has agreed

HEADLINE CHANGES

- **5 FACULTIES**

- Faculty of Arts and Humanities
- Faculty of Engineering and Physical Sciences
- Faculty of Environmental and Life Sciences
- Faculty of Medicine
- Faculty of Social Sciences

- **VOLUNTARY SEVERANCE**

- University intending to save ~£20m on staff costs – 50 to 75 members of staff at present
- Decisions on areas/magnitude made by Deans

WHAT DO WE KNOW?

- **STUDENT FEELING**

- Email, Making Change Summit & Petition

- **LACK OF INFORMATION**

- Concerns about the lack of information to any group
- Particularly pressing considering the close proximity to Spring Elections

- **ACADEMIC REPRESENTATION**

- The structure is going to need changing quite a bit
- Education Zone is already working at this

- **IMPACT ON STUDENT EXPERIENCE**

- University has said that this will not happen
