About volunteering with SUSU:

The Union's mission: **unlocking the potential and enriching the life of every student. As a student-led organisation the hard work and dedication of our student volunteers is vital to our mission.**

As a Student Officer, you will be responsible for representing a particular cohort of students. Your role will be to be a key point of contact between these students and the Union. This might mean seeking out their feedback on issues that might affect them, promoting relevant events or activities, or just being a visible point of contact for the students you represent.

You will have regular 1:1 meetings with your relevant Sabbatical Officer who will be able to support and advise you in the work that you want to do. We provide full training at the beginning of the year as well as advice and support as you continue in your role. You will gain a wealth of experience through your voluntary role with SUSU, experience that you can use to improve your future employability while receiving recognition for the work you accomplish.

While volunteering with the Union as Intra Mural Officer, your role in this mission is described below.

The main purpose of your role:

- 1)** Chair the Intramural Committee (IMC)
- 2)** Represent the interests of SUSU's intramural sports teams
- 3)** Promote the benefits of intramural sport and increase participation

The main responsibilities of your role:

Chair the Intramural Committee

- Ensure that regular meetings are held and attended by sports reps
- Take the lead on any changes to intramural league rules, as well as helping resolve any disputes within the leagues
- Be the main point of contact for any pitch cancellations or last minute changes to schedules



Intra Mural Officer

Represent the interests of SUSU's intramural sports teams

- Work closely with the VP Sports to feedback any issues or concerns that arise within intramural sports leagues
- Work with SUSU staff to organise referee/umpire familiarisation courses for the intramural leagues when required
- Help co-ordinate any intramural teams that compete in Varsity

Promote the benefits of intramural sport and increase participation

- Promote the intramural fayre/bunfight at the start of term
- Keep up communication between captains throughout the year
- Devise projects, events, and strategies to drive recruitment and improve participation in intramural leagues throughout the year
